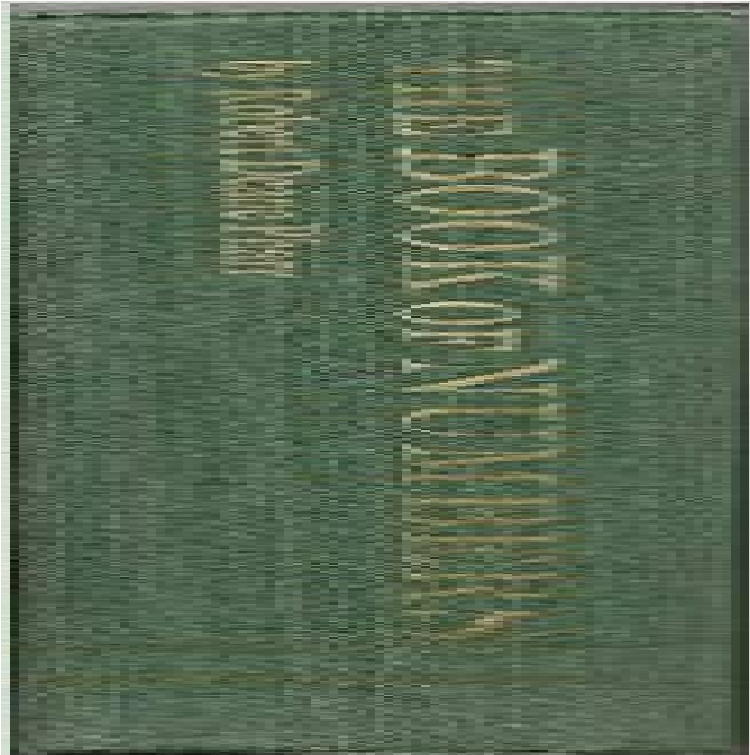


The book of numbers
