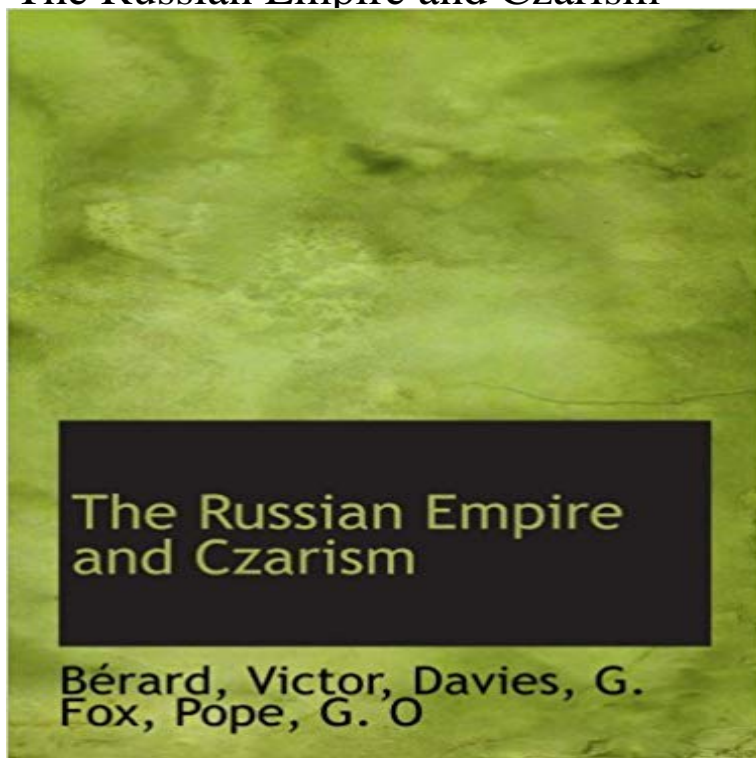


The Russian Empire and Czarism
