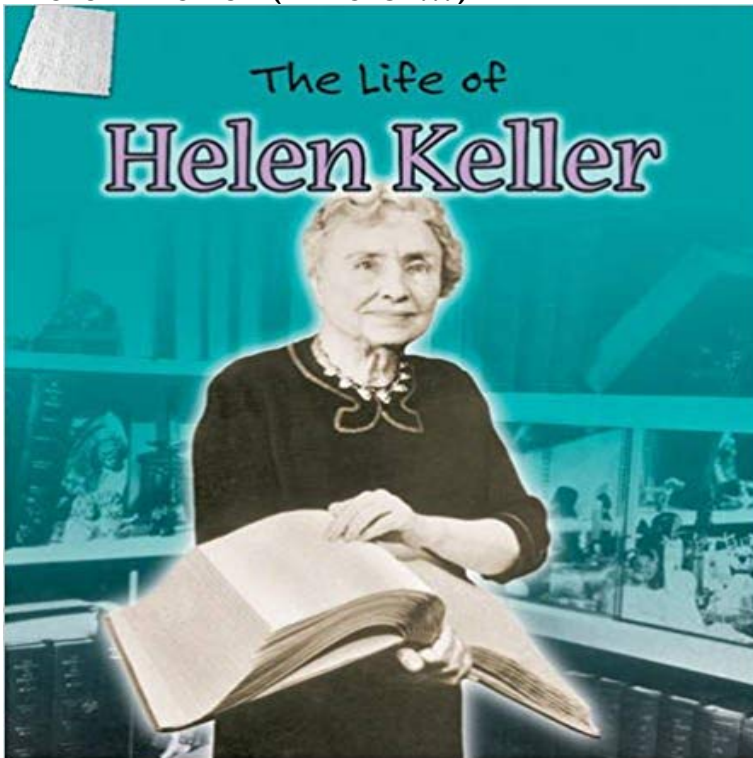


## Helen Keller (Life of...)
